You can also choose to have email alerts sent periodically to keep you updated on the latest additions to the national, regional, and state partners' *LINC'S* sites.

*LINC'S* Grants and Funding resource is a dynamic site with the most up-to-date information about funding opportunities for the adult education and family literacy community. This site contains approximately 500 current funding opportunities available from federal government, state and local government, private industry, foundations, and other funding sources. You can also search the site by program subject area, funding range, or by the type of organization of either the funder or the applicant in order to find the funding streams that best match your needs.
