Each year, ABLE students are invited to submit writing for possible publication in *Beginnings*. Since 1998, *Beginnings* has included writing of all genres—poetry, short stories, stream of consciousness, memoirs, essays, letters, and personal histories.

Entries are evaluated in a blind review process and judged on the following criteria: content, organization/structure, creativity, and mechanics. After the selections have been made, the chosen authors are invited to the annual Ohio Writers' Conference where professional authors and storytellers provide them with guidance and inspiration on expanding and improving their writing. The day culminates in the presentation of certificates, an autograph session, and voluntary reading of submissions. The conference is an opportunity for Ohio ABLE students to be applauded for their efforts and accomplishments.
