\begin{array}{|l|l|}\hline \text { Activities } & \begin{array}{l}\text { Step 1-Survey students to find out how many own vs rent their } \\
\text { residences. Discuss where they live - house, apartment, condo, } \\
\text { townhouse. Discuss what they like about it and what they would } \\
\text { like to change. } \\
\text { Step 2 - Explain that today's lesson will help them find local } \\
\text { properties for rent that meet their needs. Distribute the } \\
\text { Abbreviations for Rental Property Advertisements worksheet. } \\
\text { Step 3 - Explain that abbreviations are often used in classified } \\
\text { advertisements because space is limited and larger ads are more } \\
\text { expensive. Students read the abbreviations and meanings listed } \\
\text { on the worksheet. If they do not understand the meanings, they } \\
\text { may use a dictionary or ask the teacher for help. Modified } \\
\text { definitions or translations can be written in the blank lines as } \\
\text { needed. }\end{array}
