## **Learner Prior Knowledge**

Student must understand what an abbreviation is.

#### **Activities**

<u>Step 1</u> Distribute the list of commonly used abbreviations. Read with students. Ask students to brainstorm ways to remember each abbreviation. Ideas may include mnemonic devices, word parts (etymology), making flashcards, writing the abbreviations and their meanings five times each, and so on.

<u>Step 2</u> Students should choose one study technique and study the list of words.

<u>Step 3</u> When the student feels ready, have him/her complete the abbreviation quiz.

<u>Step 4</u> Have the student correct his completed quiz by using the list of common medical abbreviations as his guide.
