Standard(s) Addressed in Lesson Read with Understanding																				
Benchmark(s) Addressed in Lesson R.1.3 – identify and apply phonemic awareness and decoding skills to read words																				
Materials Scrabble game, paper, pencil, teacher- made rhyming paper																				
Learner Prior Knowledge Student should know the sounds of vowels and consonants and understand what rhyming words are.																				
Activities <u>Step 1</u> - Student puts all the Scrabble tiles on the table face up. <u>Step 2</u> - Student chooses one of the endings from the rhyming paper and makes the ending from the Scrabble tiles. Example: Student chooses “-ook” from the paper and puts the “ook” tiles on the table. <u>Step 3</u> - Student puts a tile in front of the “ook” to make a rhyming word. Example: Student puts the “b” tile in front of “ook” and makes the word “book.” Student writes the word on the blank paper. Student continues making as many rhyming words for “ook” as he can by shifting the tiles and writes them on the paper. Student should focus on making words related to their job, family, or interests. Examples: book, cook, look; toy, boy, joy <u>Step 4</u> -Student chooses another ending and continues the process, making as many rhyming words as possible with that ending. The process continues for a specific time period determined by the teacher or student.																				
Assessment/Evidence Teacher checks paper and asks student to give some rhyming words for an ending not completed by the student.																				
Adaptations for Beginning Students Teacher works with the student until the student can do it alone.																				

Adaptations for Advanced Students

Student makes up rhyming words without using the teacher-made paper with the endings.
