Aspire instructors can upload student writing by logging into the Aspire Professional Development System at www.ohioaspire.org. The deadline for submissions is March 10, 2022. Entries are evaluated in a blind review process and judged on the following criteria: content, organization/structure, creativity, and mechanics. After the selections have been made, the chosen authors will be published in *Beginnings XXIV*.

Aspire students are also encouraged to submit art for inclusion in the 24th edition of the publication. Artwork will be judged on originality and how the piece best captures the "spirit" of *Beginnings*.
